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<p>Pursuant to 22-43.7-103(7) C.R.S., an eligible Charter school for BEST financial assistance means a charter school as described in section 22-54- 124(1)(f.6)(I)(A) or (1)(f.6)(I)(B) and which has been in existence for at least three years at the time the application is submitted as pursuant to 22-43.7-109(b) C.R.S. This list only reflects eligible charter schools and institute charter schools who have notified BEST. A charter school intending to apply for BEST financial assistance must notify the Division of Capital Construction of its intent to apply by December 15th, 2024, then complete and return a matching requirements questionnaire in order to apply. The Division must collect data from a charter school wishing to apply in order to generate a match percentage for the charter school prior to the opening of the online grant application. Charter schools are encouraged to notify the Division as early as possible even if they are not certain they will apply.</p>
