



Autism Evaluation Training

VIRTUAL TRAINING

Overview: This training will be presented over four days, in three-hour segments. The training is designed to support districts in understanding how to identify students suspected of having Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), using evaluation tools to assess the triad of characteristics of ASD. Participants will learn how to build a body of evidence to support the identification of ASD (determining eligibility) in an educational setting (without using the ADOS).

Details

- Registration is limited and will close two weeks prior to the start date.

Who should attend:

- Certified school professionals involved in assessment for the educational identification of ASD, including: school psychologists, social workers, speech/language pathologists, special education teachers, occupational therapists, district administrators, and other certified staff who are part of the evaluation team.
- This training is not open to paraeducators.
- *Priority will be given to those individuals who have not previously attended.*



Cost: The Exceptional Student Services Unit of the Colorado Department of Education provides the funding for the presenters. No reimbursement is provided to participants.



Participants must complete all four virtual sessions to receive a certificate of attendance (12 CDE hours). Partial credit will not be given.
