Colorado is excited to introduce a new Framework to support families, educators, and service providers working with students and youth with disabilities.

The Sequencing of Services Framework was developed to increase collaboration among schools and community partners to support students and youth with disabilities with progressing towards their post-secondary goals for life after high school.

The Framework is designed to assist local interagency transition teams in identifying what programming and services are available to students and youth as well as roles and responsibilities of agencies in providing these services.



6 Core Outcomes

The Sequencing of Services Framework has 6 Core Outcomes that outline skills to develop, services to access, and agencies/partners to connect with for students ages less than 14 up to age 24

- Build Self-Determination and Leadership Skills
- Build Skills to Safely Navigate Community and Access Services
- Understand Post-Secondary Options

- Develop Competence in Computer and Digital Literacy
- Expectation of Competitive Employment
- Understand Disability and Health
 Management
